Citizen Concerns

- The committee and the town received a letter from Verizon regarding a substantial increase in FIOS service and equipment pricing. The committee has also previously received a letter with a citizen concern regarding the increase in Verizon FIOS cable service pricing. The committee members expressed disappointment with this development and plan to bring the issue up at next meeting with the Verizon representative. Also, the committee raised a question of whether there is enough cable competition in town given that Verizon is able to substantially increase the service fees.
