also present: S. Kennedy, D. Lee

1. Commissioners reviewed specs for new cemetery 1-ton dump truck  
Question the need for a beacon, feel there is no need for a spotlight  
Think we should continue with an eight-foot plow, feel nine foot plow would be too wide for some of the cemetery roads
2. S. Kennedy reported the following during the discussion of the new section to be developed at Woodlawn:  
D. Charter told S. Kennedy to also lay out an area at the rear of Section 9  
S. Kennedy & D. Lee laid out the area designated above  
Before D. Charter left for vacation, he, S. Kennedy and D. Lee walked the newly laid out area as well as the area of section 14.  
D. Charter asked S. Kennedy to get quotes for clear cutting and chipping section 14 alone, the area to the rear of section 9 alone, and for the two areas together
3. W. Mowry expressed the Commissioners concerns about the number of man hours worked outside the cemeteries  
As of March 7, 1,318.5 man hours at a cost of \$14,192.49 have been expended on work outside of the cemeteries  
  
A few years ago, the Commissioners were told that as a non-union department, we could not hire a man full-time to schedule as a cemetery maintenance man (non-union dept.) for a designated portion of the year, and plan on using him regularly in another (union) dept. for the rest of the year. The Commissioners feel that this is exactly what is happening presently.
