### **I. Business**

1. GAB update
2. Department of Public Works Committee update
  - Dean Charter provided an introduction of the Department of Public Works buildings – existing fuel station site. Might get ahead of replacing the fuel station building ahead of the entire building.
  - Presentation shown by Weston & Sampson; participants asked several questions about the design of the building to be net-zero, including vehicle electrification
  - Kim Kastens presented perspective from OARS on high conductivity measured along the creek – one assumption is that this is coming from the salt storage shed. Dean mentioned that it could likely be coming from washing the vehicles; Weston & Sampson noted that could implement a wash bay connected to a tight bay to meet all of the MEP requirements
  - GAB will ask questions in writing and send them to Erik L. & Dean
  - Will be looking at a warrant article to get to the next stage of design for this; Dean mentioned the earlier we can get questions answered the better – by September 1<sup>st</sup>.
3. Climate Action Plan Update
