Virtual Meeting

7:15 The Chairman, Terry Maitland, opened the meeting and read virtual meeting guidelines. The Chairman also announced that the hearing for 12 Spring Hill Road would be continued to the virtual meeting on June 21st.

Regular Business

7:15 **Notice of Intent:** 19 Keefe Road; DEP 85-13XX (Continued)

Representing the applicant was Bert Hamill. Bert explained that since the last hearing he has gathered more information and the plan has been adjusted. He stated that the Town Engineer checked the culvert under the road and that it appears to be clear and flowing. The new plan removed the wall, some fencing and bollards. The only things that remain are a small fence, a small shed and some pavement repair. Additionally, the plan called for a cleaning of the area along the river bank.

Amy Green moved to issue a standard order of conditions, with one special condition that the applicant coordinate with the Conservation Agent before doing any restoration along the bank.

Representing the Town of Acton was Matt Lundsted of Comprehensive Environmental. Matt showed the engineering plan and addressed the questions that came up at the previous hearing. The following are the answer to those questions:

- The work will be done with a skid steer
- Soil has been tested around the bridge
- Thin protective mats will be used to access the area of the work
