Chair Charter opened the meeting at 7:31 PM

I Regular Business

1. **Citizens' Concerns** – None
2. **Review and Approval of Meeting Minutes**- The Committee reviewed the August 22, 2023, CPC minutes. Colman moved to approve the minutes as posted, seconded by Berry. Trimble called the roll, and the minutes were approved with one abstain (Trimble).

II. New /Special Business

3. Discussion with Dog Park Committee on future funding request

- i. Gillispie reviewed the dog park features and funding sources. He then reviewed certain health, safety and accessibility needs for CPA consideration.
- ii. Charter asked if the work could meet 2023-2024 schedule or could some of this move to following year. Gillispie believes the work will proceed but all the desired features may not be complete (walls, etc). Colman asked about storm water management. Tom noted the gentle slope and no serious concerns to date by Stansky and McNary.
- iii. Foster asked about town funding. Trimble suggested he request Melissa Settapani raise this ask to the Town Manager (TM) to determine direction. Colman noted the items requested fall under standard recreational asks and sees nothing unusual.

4. Public Hearing; Hear comments/questions on the draft 2024 Community Preservation Plan

- i. Cooney asked about signage language. There was some discussion on how quickly projects should begin after funding. Charter noted they should be within 3 years Foster noted that costs change so the sooner the better.
- ii. Colman noted some wording issues that were fixed.

5. Ratification of 2024 CPA Plan

Foster moved to ratify the 2024 CPA Plan. Ellicks seconded as amended. Trimble called the roll, and the motion carried as amended.

6. Discussion regarding permanent signage for projects funded with CPA funds

- i. Charter noted in discussion with Kaila Sauer (planning) that we will ask each project for draft wording and where the sign will be noted. The Chair will work out fine details with flexibility in mind.
- ii. Colman agrees but asked about common element (Town seal or CPC...consistent font or color. Town seal or CPC...consistent font or color). Planning will work up some sample language.
- iii. Berry noted we might suggest \$1000 for sign cost and that submitters need to make sure it's in the application. Charter asked to add to form not in the plan.
