Acton Residents Reminded to Register to Vote by March 6 For Annual Town Election & Town Meeting

ACTON -- Town Manager John Mangiaratti would like to remind residents to register to vote so that they can participate in the upcoming election and Town Meeting.

Any Acton resident who is at least 18 years old is eligible to register to vote and is encouraged to do so.

Residents can register in person at the Town Clerk's Office, 472 Main Street, or on the Secretary of State's website at sec.state.ma.us. They can also contact the Town Clerk's Office to check their voter status at 978-929-6620.

In order to vote in the next Town election, which will be held on March 26, residents need to register by March 6. The Town Clerk's Office will stay open until 8 p.m. on March 6 to ensure residents are able to register.

The annual town election is to select a Town Moderator, two members of the Board of Selectmen, two members of the School Committee, a Memorial Library Trustee and one Acton Water District Commissioner.

Precincts 1, 2 and 6 will vote at the Conant School, 80 Taylor Road with precincts 3, 4 and 5 at the R.J. Grey Junior High School, 16 Charter Road. Residents who need an absentee ballot should contact the Town Clerk.

Registered voters will also have the opportunity to participate in the annual Town Meeting, which is scheduled to begin on Monday, April 1. Town Meeting will be held in the Acton Boxborough Regional High School auditorium, 36 Charter Road. The warrant will be mailed to each household and will be posted online (actonma.gov/townmeeting) on March 12.
