The Acton Health Division is requesting the following message be dispensed to the community:

The Acton Board of Health is accepting applications for medical and non-medical volunteers to become members of the Town of Acton's Medical Reserve Corps (MRC). An MRC is a network of residents and professionals who are interested in serving the Town of Acton and beyond by providing medical, public and mental health support during an emergency. Emergencies range from disease outbreaks, to toxic chemical releases, to storms which can displace groups of residents from their homes for extended periods of time. A member of the MRC will benefit from free training and continuing education in areas including but not limited to CPR/first aid, sheltering, incident command system, and personal protection during an emergency. The MRC will also become familiar with local emergency plans, procedures and facilities. An MRC member may choose to stay local or be a part of a regional or nationwide response team.
