RE: Amendments to Existing Board of Health Orders Related to COVID-19

At its meeting Wednesday, May 20, 2020, the Board of Health voted to amend the previously issued local orders related to COVID-19 to align with the reopening plans presented by the Governor on May 18, 2020 and further clarified at the following website: <https://www.mass.gov/info-details/covid-19-state-of-emergency>.

The local orders that have been amended are outlined below:

PUBLIC BUILDING CLOSURE TO MINIMIZE THE RISK OF COVID-19:

The Board of Health amended its March 16, 2020 Public Building Closure Order to align with the new State requirements, safety standards and restrictions effective May 25, 2020.

PERSONAL CARE BUSINESS CLOSURE:

The Board of Health amended its March 19, 2020 Elective Personal Care Businesses Order to align with the new State requirements, safety standards and restrictions effective May 25, 2020. This amendment only pertains to barbers and hairdressers that are subject to its requirements and restrictions.

NARA PARK CLOSURE:

The Board of Health amended its April 6, 2020 NARA Park Closure Order to align with the new State requirements, safety standards and restrictions effective May 25, 2020. This amended order only partially reopens the park for limited activities with restrictions. This amendment reopens the facility to allow transitory activities including walking, selected non-contact sports only, among individuals from the same household, and the public restrooms. All individuals visiting the park are still subject to the requirements for face coverings, social distancing and limitations on gatherings.
